SUBSCRIPTION EMS**

Attention New Haven residents! If you live in New Haven or the surrounding EMS coverage area, the New Haven Subscription EMS Service is being offered once again. The New Haven Subscription EMS Service is all about protecting you and your family while simultaneously supporting the New Haven-Adams Township EMS Service. It is important to know that any revenue generated by subscription sales help in the operation of our local EMS without raising taxes in the process.

MEMBERSHIP

If you are currently a member, an invoice will be mailed directly to you for your renewal convenience. If you are not a member, please look for our mailer which will offer this subscription and give you a chance to protect you and your family.

COVERAGE AND WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

It is important to note that a subscription to the EMS Service is not an insurance policy, but it is a way to limit the amount you would have to pay for expenses that your insurance company does not pay related to ambulance charges. Even if you have health insurance coverage, most insurance companies do not pay 100% of costs related to ambulance bills.

Your subscription will cover any co-pays or deductibles not covered by your health insurance carrier. Residents should also be aware that the similarly advertised subscription to LIFECARE (through Three Rivers Ambulance Authority) will not be accepted in the areas serviced by New Haven EMS. TRAA no longer services the New Haven area, so if you work or live in the New Haven EMS coverage area, purchasing a New Haven EMS subscription is the way to go! *Note: Although New Haven only accepts the New Haven Subscription, residents are able to carry more than one coverage plan in the area.

COST

For a \$55.00 fee, a subscription covers you, your spouse, and any children under the age of 21 living at home (26 if a full time college student living at home) for one year. A subscription purchase is intended to limit a family's out of pocket expenses in relation to medically necessary treatment and/or transportation to a medical facility as provided by the New Haven EMS.

APPLICATION & METHOD OF PAYMENT

The City of New Haven will sponsor its annual “City Wide Clean Up” on **Saturday, April 15, 2017** to local residents. Materials will be collected at the New Haven City Hall Building, north parking lot, 815 Lincoln Highway East, from **7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** For more questions, contact Dave Jones, Superintendent of Utilities at 748-7056.

DROP OFF

815 Lincoln Highway East (New Haven City Hall Building). Enter the parking lot using the entrance on Lincoln Highway. The drive through drop off site will be located at the north side of the building (behind City Hall) and you will need to exit west of the City Hall building onto High Street. New Haven Residents **MUST** bring a valid driver’s license and/or recent water/sewer bill.

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED

- Asbestos materials
- Automotive fluids
- Business or industrial trash
- Car batteries
- Electronics
- Explosives
- Industrial hazardous waste
- Infectious waste
- Mercury containing items
- Oil based or latex paint
- Paint thinner
- Pool chemicals
- Radioactive materials
- Steel drums
- Tires
- Toxic household cleaners

SPECIFICATIONS

- All unwanted RESIDENTIAL trash will be inspected before it is accepted for disposal.
- Only pick-up truck size loads or smaller will be accepted.
- One (1) drop off load per household will be accepted.
- Appliances that utilize Freon **MUST** have a certificate of Freon removal before they will be accepted.

This is offered to New Haven residents. In order to provide this service on an annual basis, we will evaluate the response and participation each year and possibly lift certain restrictions in the future. Republic Services will provide dumpsters as well as the disposal of unwanted residential trash and waste collection. This service is **FREE** to New Haven residents, therefore, we strongly encourage you to participate by bringing your unwanted items to the location listed above.

SENIOR CITIZENS

In addition, this year the City of New Haven would like to offer pick up service for our senior citizens who are unable to utilize the drop off site.

Please call New Haven City Hall and leave your address along with a brief description of items to be collected prior to April 15, 2017. A truck will come to your home between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 15, 2017.
