2017 Leaf Pick Up Schedule



Leaves should be ready on the first pick up day of the week that crews are scheduled to be in your part of the city. Leaves must be raked onto the park strip between the sidewalk and curb (**NOT IN THE STREET**), and away from street signs, poles, mailboxes and parked cars. Long rows are preferred over one big pile. All leaves will be picked up as close to the published schedule as possible.
